Meeting Called to Order -- The 2017 Annual Town Meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman Knutzen.

Officials Present: Chairman-Dan Knutzen, Supervisor 1-Dan Rettler, Supervisor 2-Tom Neubert, Treasurer-Jeri Ohman, Constable-Mike Garvey, and Clerk-Karen Herman. A total of forty-eight people were present including guest speaker Christine Miller, Recycling Coordinator with the Outagamie County Solid Waste Department; Sgt. Nate Borman with the Outagamie County Sheriff's Department (left the meeting after his presentation); and Andy Gayhart with Harter's Fox Valley Disposal.

The newly elected officers were introduced.

Pledge of Allegiance -- The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Meeting Posted & Published According to the Open Meeting Law -- Published in the ACN/Times Press the week of April 10, 2017; posted April 6, 2017 at the 3-posting places, Town Hall front door, town website; and Town's 2016 Annual Report mailed on March 31, 2017.

2016 Annual Meeting Minutes -- <u>MOTION: Mike Garvey/John Riehl approved the annual report as presented. All said aye. Motion carried.</u>

2016 Annual Report -- The 2016 Annual Report reviewed and discussion took place.

Guest Speaker: Christine Miller, Outagamie County Recycling Coordinator -- Recycling Stretchy Plastic Bags and Wraps -- Chris brought along the 2017 Tri-County Recycling Guide. Residents should bring their clean & dry (stretchy) plastic film packaging, bags & wraps at participating stores, for example: Don's Quality Market (Seymour), Shopko, Walmart, Target, Festival, Piggly Wiggly, Pick & Save, and Kohl's. Please DO NOT place plastic film packaging, bags & wraps into your semi-weekly recycling collection with the hauler. Christine mentioned that after each shift, the county sorting machine is tagged out and people manually cut out the plastic bags/film from the recycling screens. This is a cumbersome job and the large amount of plastic film/bags cut from the screens are too dirty to recycle. Examples of stretchy recyclable plastic film packaging, bags & wraps to bring back to the stores (example of stores are listed above): Store Plastic shopping bags, pallet bags, water softener salt bags, food storage bags, bread bags, produce bags, plastic shipping envelopes, case wrap (from water bottles etc.), air pillows & bubble wrap, newspaper bags, product over wrap (from toilet paper, paper towels etc.). These recyclables are made into plastic lumber. Feed plastic bags that have fiber woven in the plastic, many layers of plastic, or chemically coated plastic are not recyclable. Please make sure the dirty and unrecyclable bags and film are placed in your weekly garbage bags so they don't blow around on windy days.

Guest Speaker: Sgt. Nate Borman, Outagamie County Sheriff's Department – Sheriff's

<u>Department Update and Response Time</u> -- There have been 7 fatal crashes due to seat belt and alcohol issues but there are usually around 2, this time of the year. There has been an increase in heroin overdoses, methamphetamines in January 2017 then all of last year. If you notice an increase of short term traffic, notify the Sheriff's Department, it can be drug related. The K-9 program has 2 bomb dogs and 3 drug dogs on every shift which has been very useful.

The Sheriff's Department will move out of downtown Appleton to Goodland Dr. (by Encircle Health). Moving to the NE side of the city will improve response times.

Christine Miller mentioned that old/unwanted medication can be dropped off at the Appleton, Seymour, and New London Police Departments.

Guest Speaker: Andy Garyhart, Harter's Fox Valley Disposal, Pros & Cons with Garbage/Recycling Carts -- At the end of this year, the Town's contract will be up with Harter's. The Cart process is cheaper and people recycle more with carts. The Town can rent or buy carts. If renting, the hauler repairs the carts. The carts get more fragile after 10 years of use. There is a 10 year warranty by the manufacturer for the carts. Harter's has 100,000 carts in 80 communities. Stolen carts will be the resident's responsibility. Harter's currently uses 1 truck to collect all garbage and recycling within the Town of Black Creek now. Remember to put your garbage in a plastic bag and your recycling is not bagged.

Last week our town roads reflected a Harter's truck hydraulic fluid leak (50-60 gallon tank).

Other Topics:

New Road Name Signs and Posts Damaged/Theft – There has been theft and damage to our road signs which includes Genske, Jochman, and Stingle Rd, to name a few. It costs \$260 per road sign set and it's a Federal offense for stealing stop signs. This spring the vandalism and theft cost \$920 for signs and poles. Insurance has been contacted and will cover ¾ of the cost with a \$500 town deductible.

<u>Tire/Scrap Metal Collection Update</u> – This past Saturday was tire/scrap metal collection here at the town hall. A lot of Bud/Busch light cans are in the ditches on Ballard Rd. Electronic recycling notices were available for FVTC, Fox Valley Lutheran, and Menasha.

<u>Town Road Work</u> – Brian Gruendemann has been patching our town roads. Discussion took place regarding the gravel on Mullen Rd. Ballard Rd is rough vs Osborn's side has newer blacktop. The Wolfgrams are concerned with the speed limit being too fast on the curve of Sate Rd. New town hall flag needs to be replaced.

<u>Set Date for 2018 Annual Meeting</u> -- Wednesday, April 18, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. Carol Theobald asked if a tree branch collection would be possible. Knutzen will look into.
